The Atlantic City Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall with Mayor Jones presiding. Council Members present were: Jimerson, Somers, Hayes, Hartkopf, Casady, Halder, and Cord. Absent: none.

Hayes moved, Hartkopf seconded, to amend the agenda by moving item #5 to follow after item #2, and to approve the rest of the agenda as posted. All in favor.

Hayes moved, Hartkopf seconded, to approve the consent agenda which includes: minutes of the February 17 and February 24, 2016 Council Meetings, a Class C Beer Permit for Casey's General Store (1408 East 7<sup>th</sup> Street), and a Solid Waste Collector's Permit for Green RU, LLC. All in favor.

Parks & Recreation Director Roger Herring and Assistant Parks & Recreation Director Seth Staashelm presented plans for improvements to the Schildberg Recreation Area. The improvements are estimated to cost \$635,000 and among other things include a shelter house/bathrooms/showers, playground equipment, and a fishing pier. Herring explained how the first phase of the project, which will cost \$360,000, is to be funded. It will include grant funds from Vision Iowa of \$180,000 and the need for a commitment from the City of \$100,000.

Hayes moved, Jimerson seconded, to adopt resolution #5-16 entitled, **"RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE USE OF CITY FUNDS FOR MATCHING FUNDS FOR VISION IOWA COMMUNITY ATTRACTION & TOURISM GRANT."** All in favor.

Mayor Jones opened the public hearing as officially published regarding the voluntary annexation of property located at 56988 635<sup>th</sup> Street.

No written or oral comments were filed.

Jimerson moved, Hartkopf seconded, to close the public hearing. All in favor.

Somers moved, Halder seconded, to adopt resolution #3-16 entitled, **"A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY LOCATED AT 56988 635<sup>TH</sup> STREET, ATLANTIC, IA 50022."** All in favor.

City Administrator John Lund reported on a several items including: a change in financial advisors regarding bond issues, a meeting with State Legislators, and an equipment conference recently attended by two employees from the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Council Committee reports were as follows: Cord-Safety & Wellness Committee; Somers-Cass County Environmental Agency; Jimerson-Fire Department.

Jimerson moved, Hartkopf seconded, to approve the bills totaling \$88,282.76. All in favor.

Jimerson moved, Halder seconded, to adjourn at 5:53 p.m. All in favor.
