April 19, 2017 County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. with all members present: Gaylord Schelling, chair; Steve Baier, Stephen Green, Frank Waters and Mark Wedemeyer. Agenda upon motion by Wedemeyer, 2nd by Green was approved. Minutes of April 12, 2017 upon motion by Baier, 2nd by Waters were approved.
