SPEED LIMIT

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS: The Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.255 and 321.285 Subsection 7 of the Code of Iowa to determine, upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation conducted by the Iowa Department of Transportation, that the speed limit of any secondary road is greater than is reasonable and proper under the conditions existing, and may determine and declare a reasonable and proper speed limit, and

WHEREAS: Such investigation has been requested and completed and the county engineer has concurred with recommendation of the Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cass County Board of Supervisors that speed limits be established and appropriate signs erected at the locations described as follows:

1. All those streets and alleys currently used for roadway purposes in the Highland Place Subdivision of the SW 1/4 Section 6, Township 76N, Range 36W, of the 5th P.M., Cass County. In particular, Front Street from G-30 to Highway 83, Pearl Street from G-30 to Marne Ave., (also known as 2nd St. Road), Marne Ave. from Pearl Street to Highway 83, Broadway from Second Street to Highway 83, Second Street from Pearl Street to Highway 83, all 25 M.P.H. See attached drawing.
