October 21, 2015

The Atlantic City Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall with Mayor Jones presiding. Council Members present were: Jimerson, Somers, Hayes, Hartkopf, Casady, Halder, and Cord. Absent: None.

Somers moved, Jimerson seconded, to amend the agenda by adding “Keep the Lights on After School Proclamation” after item #2. and to approve the rest of the agenda as posted. All in favor.

Somers moved, Hartkopf seconded, to approve the consent agenda which includes the minutes of the October 7, 2015 Council Meeting; Class B Native Wine Permit for Sweet Joy Shoppe; and Class C Liquor License for Nishna Hills Golf Club. All in favor.

Mayor Jones read the “Keep the Lights on After School Proclamation” and explained how this program will help children after school.

The Commission reviewed the bids for the Nishna Hills Storm Water Project.

Hartkopf moved, Casady seconded, to award Contract for Nishna Hills Storm Water Project to Crain Construction, Clarinda, IA. Passed on a 6-1 vote with Jimerson voting against.

Police Chief Steve Green gave an update on the Police Department.

City Administrator John Lund reviewed the FY 2015 Annual Urban Renewal Report with the Council and answered questions.

Jimerson moved, Hayes seconded, to approve the FY 2015 Annual Urban Renewal Report. Passed.

Lund gave an update on the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Police Department, Hazard Mitigation Plan, and Capital Improvement Plan.

Mayor Jones reminded citizens to not put their signs in the City right-of-way.

Council Committee Reports were given as follows: Cord-Chamber of Commerce and Planning & Zoning Commission; Halder-CADCO, Atlantic Municipal Utilities, and Library; Hartkopf-Airport; Hayes-Park; and Jimerson-808 Birch Abatement.

Hayes moved, Hartkopf seconded, to approve the bills totaling \$44,013.26. All in favor.

Hayes moved, Jimerson seconded, to approve the Clerk, Treasurer, Budget, General Ledger, Revenue, Airport, and Volunteer Fire Department reports for September. All in favor.

Jimerson moved, Halder seconded, to adjourn at 6:20 p.m. All in favor.
