The Atlantic City Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall with Mayor Jones presiding. Council Members present were: Jimerson, Somers, Hayes, Halder, and Cord. Absent: Hartkopf and Casady.

Hayes moved, Jimerson seconded, to approve the agenda as posted. All in favor.

Hayes moved, Halder seconded, to approve the consent agenda which includes: minutes of the October 21, 2015 meeting, Class E Liquor Licenses for Casey's General Store (701 Poplar Street), Casey's General Store (911 Southwest 7<sup>th</sup> Street), and Olsen's BP, and a Cigarette Permit for Olsen's BP. All in favor.

City Administrator John Lund reported on a number of topics including: the launching of the City's new website on November 10, and an upcoming Municipal Leadership Academy for Council Members and Mayors sponsored by the Iowa League of Cities.

Mayor Jones spoke of "no shave" November, a fund raiser by the Police Department and the importance of fiber optics for economic development since there are fiber optic cables in Atlantic not being utilized.

Council Committee reports were as follows: Somers-Cass County Environmental Agency; Jimerson-Fire Department and Cass County Public Safety Commission.

Jimerson moved, Hayes seconded, to approve the bills totaling \$996,754.19. All in favor.

There was some discussion on how the funds that were budgeted for the installation of an elevator to access the second floor of City Hall will now be used since the bond issue failed for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor City Hall Renovation Project.

Library Director Natalie Struecker presented a calendar of events to be held at the Library in November and December.

Jimerson moved, Hayes seconded, to adjourn at 5:56 p.m. All in favor.
