March 16, 2016
5:30 p.m.

The Atlantic City Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall with Mayor Jones presiding. Council Members present were: Jimerson, Somers, Hayes, Hartkopf, Casady, Halder, and Cord. Absent: none.

Hayes moved, Jimerson seconded, to amend the agenda as posted. All in favor.

Hayes moved, Hartkopf seconded, to approve the consent agenda which includes: minutes of the March 9, 2016 Council Meeting, Class E Liquor License for Wal-Mart, and a Tree Trimmer's Permit for Dimig Handyman Service, LLC. All in favor.

Dave Sturm of Snyder and Associates, Inc., spoke of how it was determined which alleys and streets were to be included in the 2016 Street and Alley Improvements Project, which is estimated to cost \$1,400,000.

Somers moved, Hayes seconded, to approve an Engineering Agreement with Snyder and Associates, Inc. for \$177,750 for the 2016 Street and Alley Improvements Project. All in favor.

The Mayor reported that he would like the Community Development Committee to begin discussions of residential garbage pickup on streets instead of the alleys. His thoughts are that a lot of damage is being done to alleys by garbage trucks and with upcoming improvements to be made to alleys, street garbage pickup would lessen future damage.

City Administrator John Lund reported on several items including: annual presentations to the Council by the various City departments and organizations, an update on bringing fiber optics to Atlantic, and a time table for various upcoming activities.

Mayor Jones noted that the Police Department will no longer be issuing warnings, but will begin issuing tickets to those operating motorcycles who violate the law.

Council Committee reports were as follows: Casady-Community Promotion Commission; Halder-Cass/Atlantic Development Corporation and Library; Cord-Chamber of Commerce.

Jimerson moved, Hartkopf seconded, to approve the bills totaling \$28,547.62. All in favor.

Hayes moved, Hartkopf seconded, to approve the Clerk, Treasurer, Budget, General Ledger, Revenue, Airport, Volunteer Fire Department, and Storm Water Utility reports for February. All in favor.

Jimerson moved, Halder seconded, to adjourn at 6:00 p.m. All in favor.
