Action Items/New Business

1. Schildberg Development Project Update: Staashelm reported the shelter is now completed with a grand opening at the next Ambassador meeting; east side playground is nearing completion with just signage needed.
2. Approval for West playground: Staashelm quoted a playground within the budgeted project; the playground comes from a sale from Boland Recreation; Staashelm gave options for additional freestanding equipment; the park board chose to do additional spring toys and 4 swing swing-set with toddler swings; motion to approve the purchase of a west Schildberg playground with 2 spring toys and a swing set made by Krogman; Beane second; motion carried unanimously.
3. Nishna Park Update: Staashelm reported to be waiting for the plan for the water quality project; Staashelm did express the importance of the project in improving water quality for the area and promoting alternative and educational plantings that would benefit the whole community.
4. Sunnyside Entrance Sign Update: The project is waiting to see if the footings will be sufficient for the sign.
5. East Ridge Park Washout Update: Staashelm hopes to have this project starting within the month; if the trail worsens, then it will be shut down.
6. Healthiest Walk at Schildberg- October 6: Smith talked about the upcoming event on what the park board could do to help; there was a correction that the event takes place on Wednesday October 3rd rather than the 6th.
