Motion by Mosier, second by Schroder to approve payment to Image Builders Committee for Christmas lights in the amount of \$4,000. All ayes. Passed.

Motion by Mosier; second by Schroder to approve funding request to Image Builders Committee for Christmas lights in the amount of \$2,000.00. This amount will be deducted from next year's budget. All ayes. Passed.

Jen McEntaffer, CADCO Executive Director, reported on Atlantic being part of Home Base Iowa, a statewide program to encourage veterans to come back to Iowa and businesses to hire them.

Motion by Mosier; second by Schroder to approve the November financial report. All ayes. Passed.

John Lund, City Administrator, spoke about reducing the fiscal year 2020 budget by \$5,900.00

Mosier recommended removing The Coca-Cola Museum for \$2,000.00, Nishna Valley Trails for \$1,000.00, and reducing the mural painting from \$10,000.00 to \$5,000.00 for the fiscal year 2020 budget.
