The Atlantic Airport Commission met in regular session with Mark Smith presiding. Members present were: Keith Harlan (by phone) and Carrol Trewet. Absent: Mike Henningsen and Bill Welter. Also present was City Council Member Linda Hartkopf (by phone), Tim Teig from Snyder and Associates, and Airport Manager Barry Reid.

Motion by Trewet, second by Harlan, to approve the agenda. All ayes; passed.

Motion by Trewet, second by Harlan, to approve the minutes of the February 13, 2019 meeting as presented. All ayes; passed.

Motion by Trewet, second by Harlan, to approve the bills totaling \$1,283.21. All ayes; passed.

Barry Reid, Airport Manager, discussed his concern for semis being on the ramp for fueling airplanes. He's concerned with the weight of the semis. He also stated there won't be room for people for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July fireworks at the airport as there is no grass. He mentioned possibly writing a letter to the Feds for letting off fireworks.

Tim Teig from Snyder & Associates discussed researching non-airport activity at the airport and also checking on the weight limit of the apron. He said he was still trying to work on a deduct with the contractor. Barricades for the cold patch should be at the airport today. The deadline for the grant involving the Walnut Grove Hangar rehab is April 26<sup>th</sup>.

Mark Smith said he would get in touch with Mark McNees, the Fire Chief of the Atlantic Fire Department, regarding the 4<sup>th</sup> of July fireworks.
