

Airport Commission  
August 14, 2019  
9:00 a.m.

The Atlantic Airport Commission met in regular session with Chairman Bill Welter presiding. Members present were: Keith Harlan and Mark Smith. Absent: Mike Henningsen and Carrol Trewet. Also present was City Council Member Linda Hartkopf, Tim Teig from Snyder and Associates, and Airport Manager Barry Reid.

Motion by Halan, second by Smith, to approve the agenda. All ayes; passed.

Motion by Harlan, second by Smith, to approve the minutes of the July 10, 2019 meeting as presented. All ayes; passed.

Motion by Smith, second by Harlan, to approve the bills totaling \$5,976.56. All ayes; passed.

Tim Teig stated PCS will move in to start the replacement of the panels on the apron and the added concrete near the T-Hangar. Also they will be replacing the damaged areas in the parking and drive. Representatives from the FAA and I-DOT were on site to review the airport facility. The FAA representatives indicated there would be funding for the maintenance improvements to the asphalt runway and replacement of the edge lights and approach aids lighting with an estimated total cost of \$2.2 million with the local match being 10%. In addition, it has been indicated by the DOT representatives that the GAVI grant will be approved for the renovation of the Walnut Grove hangar. Future projects also include an additional T-Hangar and taxiway extension whereby grant applications would be required next round.

Barry Reid reported he made more calls to surrounding airports and they only pay taxes on farm ground. He will send out letters to people who use Atlantic's airport during spraying season to inform them of recent changes to allow seasonal sprayers on a first come, first served basis on the west side of the airport property as there is limited space available.

There was discussion on issues with a tenant. Bill Welter was directed to notify the city's attorney regarding drafting eviction papers.

Motion by Smith, second by Harlan, to change the locks on the city hangar. All ayes; passed.

The next regular meeting will be Wednesday, September 11, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. at the Airport.

Motion by Harlan, second by Smith, to adjourn at 9:22 a.m. All ayes; passed.
