The Atlantic Community Promotion Commission met in regular session with Chairman Livengood presiding. Members present were: King, Landsness, Mosier, and Wieser. Absent: None.

Landsness moved, King seconded, to approve the agenda as posted. Passed.

Mosier moved, Landsness seconded, to approve the minutes of the January 8, 2015 meeting as presented. Passed.

Atlantic Area Chamber of Commerce Executive Director Ouida Wymer stated that the County will meet next week regarding the Cass Community Website, the Chamber and City would like to move forward, and CADCO is waiting on the County's answer.

Landsness moved, Wieser seconded, to approve the contribution of \$7,500 towards the Cass Community Website. Passed.

Dave Chase of Nishna Valley Trails, Inc. explained their request of \$10,000 that would go towards the signage, promotion of, and information kiosks for the Troublesome Creek Connector Trail Bridge Project.

Mosier moved, King seconded, to approve the Nishna Valley Trails, Inc.'s request of \$10,000 of which \$5,000 will be paid this fiscal year and the remaining \$5,000 next fiscal year. Passed with Landsness abstaining as he is a member of Nishna Valley Trails, Inc.

Mosier moved, Landsness seconded, to approve the Produce in the Park Planning Committee's request of \$1,000, \$500 to be paid this fiscal year and the remaining \$500 next fiscal year, to be used for the advertising and promotion of Produce in the Park. Passed.

Landsness moved, Wieser seconded, to approve the bill of \$1,400 to the Atlantic Garden Seminar Committee. Passed.

Wymer gave an update on current events.

King moved, Landsness seconded, to approve the January Finance Report with a fund balance of \$31,078.23. Passed.

The next regular Community Promotion Meeting will be Thursday, March 5, 2015 at noon.

Mosier moved, Landsness seconded, to adjourn at 12:25 p.m. Passed.
