The Atlantic City Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall with Mayor Jones presiding. Council members present were: Behrens, Somers, McCurdy, Hartkopf, Casady, Garrett, and Brink. Absent: None. Also present was Student Representative Molly McFadden.

Motion by McCurdy; second by Hartkopf to approve the agenda as posted. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Casady; second by Brink to approve the consent agenda which included the following: Minutes of the December 18, 2019 City Council meeting; Class C Liquor License with Sunday Sales and Outdoor Service for Rancho Grande; and bills totaling \$47,597.14. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Brink; second by Hartkopf to approve First Whitney Bank & Trust as the City's Official Bank for the City Checking Account for 2020. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by McCurdy; second by Hartkopf to approve Atlantic News Telegraph as the City's Official Newspaper for Legal Publications in 2020. All ayes. Motion carried.

City Administrator Lund reported the budget is moving along. The city will no longer have to estimate insurance costs. With the City Clerk being out, her duties have been divided up. He would like to meet with Personnel and Finance Tuesday, January 28, 2020 at 5:15 pm.
