The Atlantic City Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall with Mayor Jones presiding. Council members present were: Behrens, Somers, McCurdy, Garrett, and Brink. Absent: Hartkopf.

Motion by McCurdy; second by Behrens to approve the agenda as posted. All ayes. Motion carried.

Council recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Casady; second by Brink to approve the consent agenda as follows: Minutes of the October 6, 2021 City Council meeting; 5-day Class C Liquor License for Rumors (11/6/21-11/10/21); Tree Trimmer Permit for Keller's Tree Service; September 2021 Budget and Clerk's reports; and bills totaling \$87,452.97. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by McCurdy; second by Garrett to approve Resolution #55-21 "APPROVING JOB DESCRIPTION, FY 2022 COMPENSATION AND AUTHORIZING THE POSTING OF THE ASSISTANT PARKS & RECREATION DIRECTOR POSITION." Ayes: McCurdy, Casady, Garrett, Brink, Behrens, Somers. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Motion by Garrett; second by McCurdy to approve Resolution #56-21 "APPROVING SCHEDULE OF ADOPTION FEES FOR THE ATLANTIC ANIMAL SHELTER." Ayes: Garrett, Brink, Behrens, Somers, McCurdy, Casady. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Motion by Somers; second by Behrens to approve the second reading of Ordinance No. 1011 "AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ATLANTIC, IOWA BY AMENDING FIRE DEPARTMENT, CHAPTER 37, OF THE CITY CODE." Ayes: Somers, McCurdy, Casady, Garrett, Brink, Behrens. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Motion by Brink; second by McCurdy to reappoint Keith Harlan to the Airport Commission. All ayes. Motion carried.

Library Director Michelle Andersen gave the library's annual presentation.

City Administrator Lund reported: Personnel & Finance to meet October 27th to begin Personnel Policy review; meeting with Retail Coach on October 21st to discuss data findings; goal is to finish ROW permitting and Personnel Policy prior to end of year; received notice of increase in tax credit for volunteer firefighters.

Mayor Jones reminded citizens that the election is two weeks away and everyone should get out and vote. He also advised that whoever won the Mayoral election should remember what great Department Heads the city has.
