

The Atlantic City Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall with Mayor Garrett presiding. Council members present were: Otte, Behrens, Sisco, McCurdy, Hartkopf, Halder and Brink. Absent: None.

Motion by McCurdy; second by Hartkopf to approve agenda as posted. All ayes. Motion carried.

Council recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Hartkopf; second by Behrens to approve the consent agenda as follows: Minutes of the January 19, 2022 City Council meeting; Class C Liquor License with Sunday Sales and Outdoor Service Area for Plaza Azteca; and bills totaling \$64,204.75. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by McCurdy; second by Behrens to approve subrecipient agreement for federally funded project (CDBG-CV Food Pantry). All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Hartkopf; second by Halder to approve administrative agreement with SWIPCO for federally funded project (CDBG-CV Food Pantry). All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Halder; second by McCurdy to approve Resolution #06-22 "APPROVING THE JOB DESCRIPTION AND FY 2022 COMPENSATION AND AUTHORIZING THE POSTING FOR THE SUNNYSIDE POOL MANAGER POSITION" Ayes: Halder, Otte, Behrens, Sisco, McCurdy, Hartkopf. Nays: Brink. Motion carried.

City Administrator's Report: focusing on budget – need to review revenues; housing meetings; will be taking vacation once budget is completed; would like to schedule a brief work session for February 9th at 5:30 p.m.

Mayor Garrett reminded citizens to adhere to the City's snow ordinance and thanked them for doing their part; she is preparing a press release regarding the snow ordinance. Garrett then read a letter of resignation from Police Chief David Erickson, who will be retiring on March 31, 2022. She advised that the city is now working through the process of preparing for the future and selecting a replacement; she will release information as it becomes available.
