

The Atlantic City Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall with Mayor Garrett presiding. Council members present were: Otte, Sisco, McCurdy, Hartkopf, Halder and Brink. Absent: Behrens.

Motion by McCurdy; second by Brink to approve agenda as posted. All ayes. Motion carried.

Council recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Hartkopf; second by Otte to approve the consent agenda as follows: Minutes of the January 3, 2022 City Council meeting; minutes of the January 5, 2022 City Council meeting; Class E Liquor License for Fareway #940, Class C Liquor License with Sunday Sales and Outdoor Service Area for Rancho Grande, December financial and Clerk's reports; and bills totaling \$144,299.19. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by McCurdy; second by Brink to approve the agreement with the City of Massena for the Provision of Wastewater Operator services. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Hartkopf; second by McCurdy to approve the second reading of Ordinance no. 1012 "AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF ATLANTIC, IOWA, 2013, BY DIVIDING THE CITY INTO FIVE WARDS AND FIVE PRECINCTS AND OUTLINING AND DESCRIBING EACH WARD AND PRECINCT AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 934." Ayes: Hartkopf, Halder, Otte, Sisco, McCurdy. Nays: Brink. Motion carried.

Motion by McCurdy; second by Hartkopf to waive the rules and proceed with the third reading of Ordinance No. 1012. Ayes: McCurdy, Hartkopf, Otte, Sisco. Nays: Halder, Brink. Because three-fourths of the council did not vote to approve waiving the rules, the motion failed.

Motion by McCurdy; second by Sisco to approve Resolution #03-22 "ADOPTING THE CASS COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTION HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF ATLANTIC, IOWA." Ayes: McCurdy, Hartkopf, Halder, Brink, Otte, Sisco. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Motion by McCurdy; second by Hartkopf to approve Resolution #04-22 "REPEALING RESOLUTION #02-22 AND ESTABLISHING THE USE OF THE ARPA SPECIAL FUND." City Administrator Lund reported that the resolution had been revised due to the final rulings of the US Treasury. Ayes: McCurdy, Hartkopf, Halder, Brink, Otte, Sisco. Nays: None. Motion carried.

City Administrator's Report: City Council work session scheduled for January 20th at 5:15 pm; Personnel and Finance to meet on January 20th at 1:00 p.m.; Received request for stop sign at 6th and Hickory – Mayor assigned to Community Protection Committee; FY23 budget moving along; health insurance rates will increase 9.62%-looking at some different options; discussed the new city emails that had been set up for elected officials.

Mayor Garrett reported that the Atlantic Animal Shelter had received \$1,795 in donations for Betty White's birthday – donations are still coming in. Garrett also reminded the public that they have 24

hours after cessation of a snowfall to remove the snow from their sidewalks; vehicles must be moved off of streets and alleys for 24 hours following cessation of a snowfall. She asked that the public keep the streets clear for snow removal operations.

City Council Reports: Hartkopf- Airport; Brink – CPC, Park & Rec; Otte- Chamber; Sisco – AMU.

Council Member McCurdy commended the Street Departments for their snow removal operations during the recent snow storm.

Council Member Sisco mentioned that he had noticed some unoccupied store fronts along Chestnut that failed to remove snow from their sidewalks. Mayor Garrett reminded everyone that it is the property owner's responsibility to clear the snow.

Motion by McCurdy; second by Halder to adjourn at 6:05 p.m. All ayes. Motion carried.
