MSC Shouse/Holmes to approve the April financial statements and bills. Carried unanimously.

TAC Rob Koppert gave a brief report on his assistance to the Cass County Fire Association's grant application for updated communications equipment, planning efforts being done to support RAGBRAI in July and the failure of the "new" shredder. He also demonstrated the software program MACH and how it benefitted the communications center. He also discussed with the Commission, 911 call statistics and how the migration of users from landline based telephones to wireless telephones affected the communications center both financially and operationally.
