The Cass County Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 a.m. with four members present: Steve Baier, chair; Stephen Green, John Hartkopf and Mark O'Brien. Absent: Frank Waters. Agenda upon motion by Green, 2nd by Hartkopf was approved. Minutes of June 28, 2019 upon motion by O'Brien, 2nd by Green were approved.

On October 15, 2018 Connie Boose asked the board to consider the painting of murals on the garage doors on the west side of the courthouse. She had painted several Coca-Cola murals in Atlantic; and the CPC and City of Atlantic asked her to look for more places in Atlantic to paint other murals. She stated the courthouse is a beautiful art deco building, built in 1934 and she would paint art deco style murals. She suggested an eagle motif for one of the doors and a floral motif for the other. Painting and maintenance of the murals would be at no cost to the County. At that time the supervisors and county sheriff stated they had no problem with murals being painted on the garage doors. She stated she will be presenting the plan to the City and the CPC for their approval.

Connie reported that approval was given by the City and CPC and she is requesting final approval from the current board of supervisors. The Board gave final approval for the two murals: an eagle motif and a floral motif.
